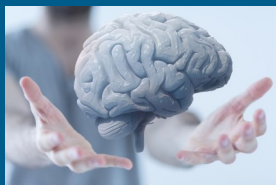
### Call for Applications: 6th annual Winter School on Responsible Innovation and Social Studies of Emerging Technologies, Arizona State University, January 3-10
