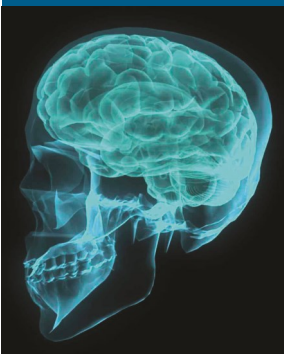
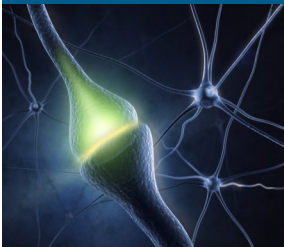
### Call for Applications: Lecturer or Assistant Professor (General Faculty) Department of Engineering and Society, University of Virginia

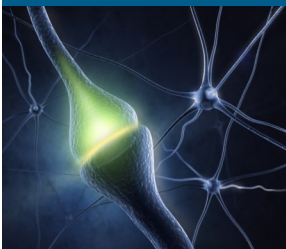

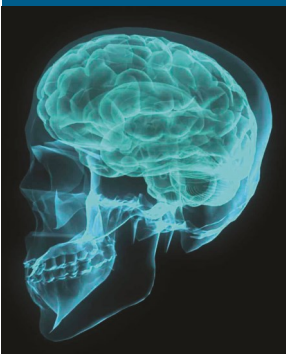
