

**Teresa Blankmeyer Burke**, Ph.D. is Professor of Philosophy at Gallaudet University, a bilingual university teaching deaf, hard of hearing, and hearing students in American Sign Language and written English. She is the only signing Deaf philosopher in the world with a doctorate in philosophy. Her academic publications are in philosophy, bioethics, research ethics, policy, and signed language interpreting ethics. She also writes for the general public, including mainstream media publications, creative nonfiction, and poetry. Dr. Burke has served on a number of national and international committees, including the United Nations, World Federation of the Deaf, the American Philosophical Association, and the National Association of the Deaf (USA).
